In 2011, The Scout Association of Belize celebrated 100 years of Scouting in Belize. In connection with the many activities organized to commemorate the occasion, a Centenary Scout Camp was held in the month of July. This camp provided an opportunity to both the organizers and the participants to display their leadership skills, have fun in a camping environment, adventure through safely organized challenging outdoor activities, share different cultures and most importantly, learn to live in a safe community among different ethnic groups.

Scouts travelled all the way from Aruba to join in the Centenary Camp celebrations and from their first encounter with the local Scouts, it was like they already knew each other. The bond of brotherhood was evident throughout the camp as Patrols competed in a number of attractive and educational events that were prepared with young people in mind by young people.

The Centenary Camp was organized by Venture Scout Fernando Oliva (now Queen's Scout) who had a number of years of experience both at local and international camps and had the support of other Venture Scouts who demonstrated true leadership skills during the entire camp.

The Belize Scout Foundation contributed \$6,000.00 towards this camp which they were happy to be associated with.

Meeting of the Building Sub-Committee May 9, 2019



The Building Sub-Committee of the Belize Scout Foundation and The Scout Association met on Thursday May 9, 2019 to finalize plans on the way forward for the construction of the "Sir Colville N. Young Building", home of Scouting in Belize.

Based on decisions taken during the meeting it is expected that within a week's time the cost schedule for the architectural work will be completed which will then enable the Scout Foundation to enter in a contractual agreement with the Architect.

It was also agreed based on cost estimates that the building will be constructed using the traditional method-concrete reinforced columns, beams and floors casted on site and walls to be of masonry cement blocks.

The initial construction phase is expected to commence within the next few months.
